

TOWN OF MILLWOOD

BUTLER WELL

Butler well is at the east end of Millwood and is not critical to maintain pressure. In the event of contamination our short range plan will be shut down the well site and run on oldpark well and see what can be done to clean up the problem. Our long range plan will include possibly looking for a new well site.

OLD-PARK WELL

Oldpark well lies in the middle of Millwood , Pumps about 1200 gpm it is the pump we run on all winter however we could run on newpark and waste some power Old park runs about 10 months out of the year ,if we lost oldpark well to contamination.

Short range plan...

With the help of several agencies, try to find out what the contamination is how fast it's moving and look at the possibilities of clean up.

Depending on whether or not the season is winter or summer , rationing might be one option . We do have two emergency water tie ins One with orchard ave and one with Irvin irrigation. Both are 6" Irvin is on our east side and Orchard ave is on our west side.

Long range plan...

It is possible we might want to put a larger pump at the Butler well site to make up the difference for the loss at oldpark.

Drilling oldpark well deeper is another option.

Drilling a new well somewhere in the town.

Water rationing and or utilizing our two tie ins.

If oldpark was contaminated we would be very concerned about newpark well since they are about 1000' apart.

NEWPARK WELL

Newpark Well is our largest pump 2200gpm Although it is only used 3 months out of the year it is very critical for summer flows and fire flows all year.

Short range plan...

Water rationing (run on oldpark if applicable)

Tie ins

Long range plan...

Drill a new well

larger pump at butler and or oldpark

CONSERVATION PLAN

In the event the Town of Millwood needed to conserve water because of an emergency water shortage. The following steps may be taken to insure adequate pressure for safety of our residents.

The town will provide literature to aide the residents in conservation of water. The West Valley school dist. and the Town of Millwood are the two big irrigators. That will be asked to quit irrigating.
Possible even odd watering days.
Total ban on irrigation.
