- Entries accepted from K through 6th grade students
- Posters must be drawn on at least 8 1/2" x 11" size paper
- You may use marker, crayon, colored pencil, paint or ink to create your poster
- All artwork must be original and be accompanied with an entry form
- Poster deadline is **Friday, April 26th, 2013**
- You may enter individually or as part of a class
- Primary considerations for judging are:
 - Use of theme and Aqua Duck- "Keep Our Drinking Water Clean"
 - Originality & correct Information

A panel of judges from KSPS and the Spokane Aquifer Joint Board will select the winning poster from each grade level. Winning entries will be posted on KSPS and SAJB websites. Winning artists will receive gift certificates compliments of Whiz Kids and Mobius Science Center.
