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Poster Contest

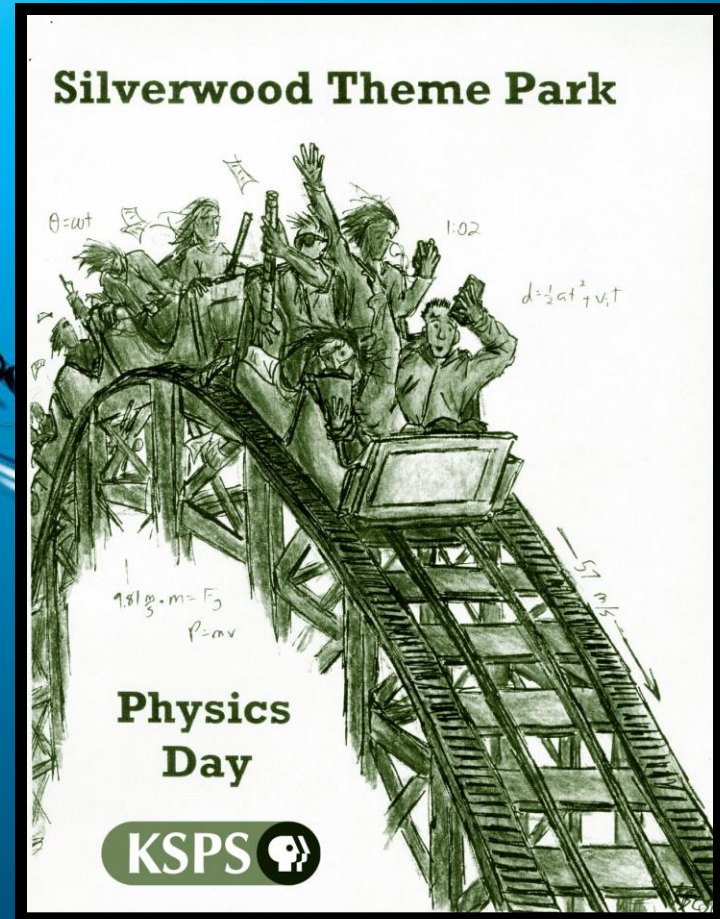


The five winners of the contest and their teachers received a backpack of books, fun water activities, and a pass to Mobius Science Center .
