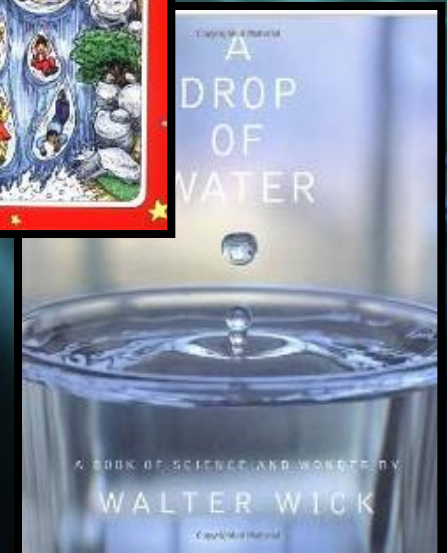
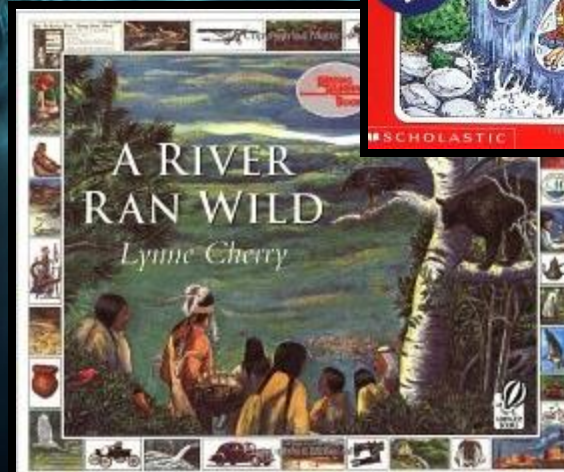
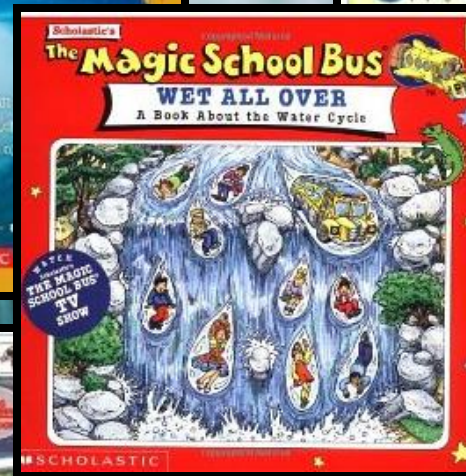
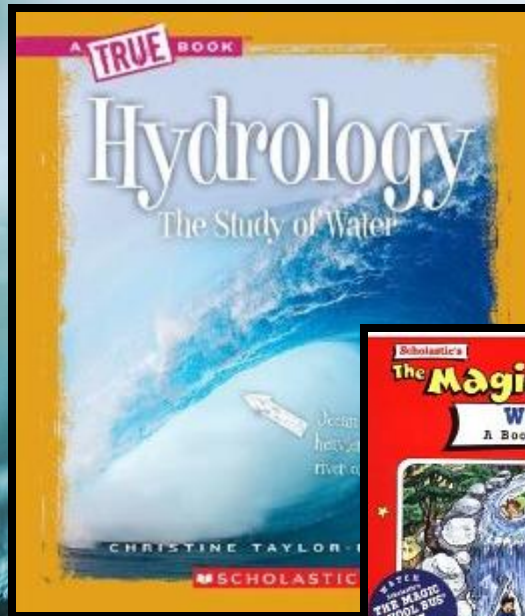
Workshop Stats
