Poster Contest

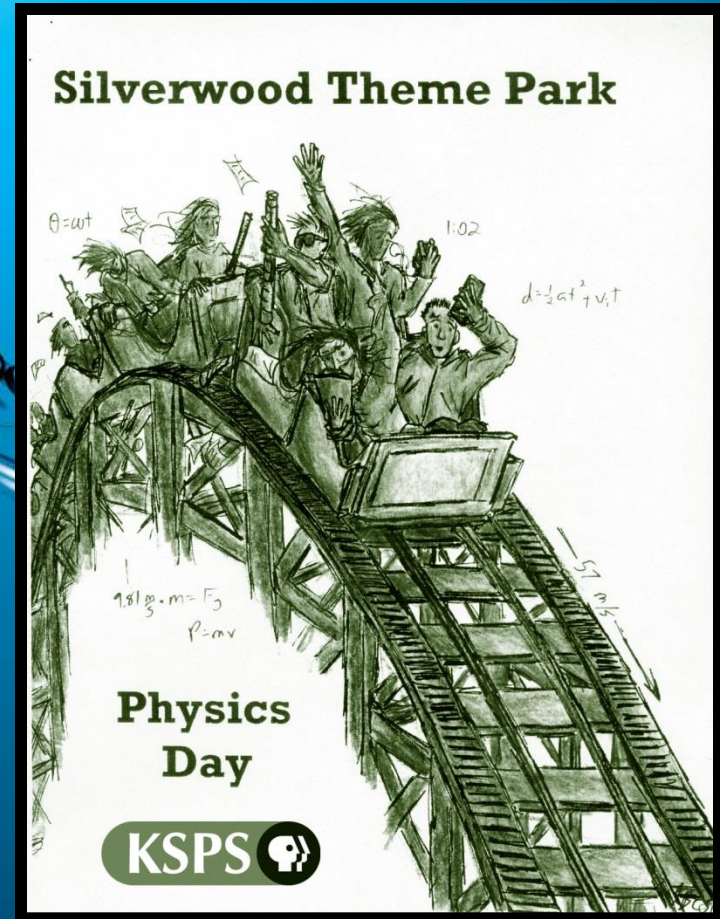


The five winners of the contest and their teachers received a backpack of books, fun water activities, and a pass to Mobius Science Center .

There he greeted families and handed out comic books to enthusiastic fans.

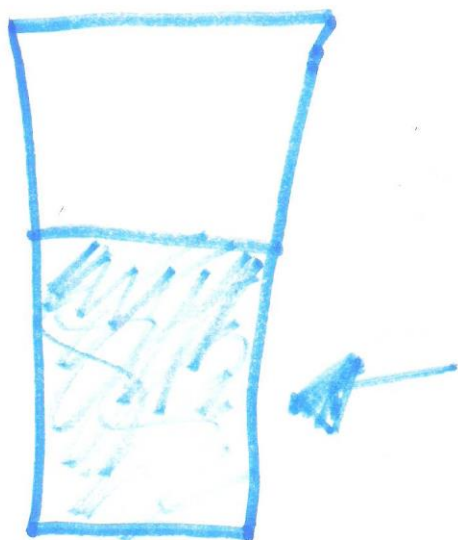

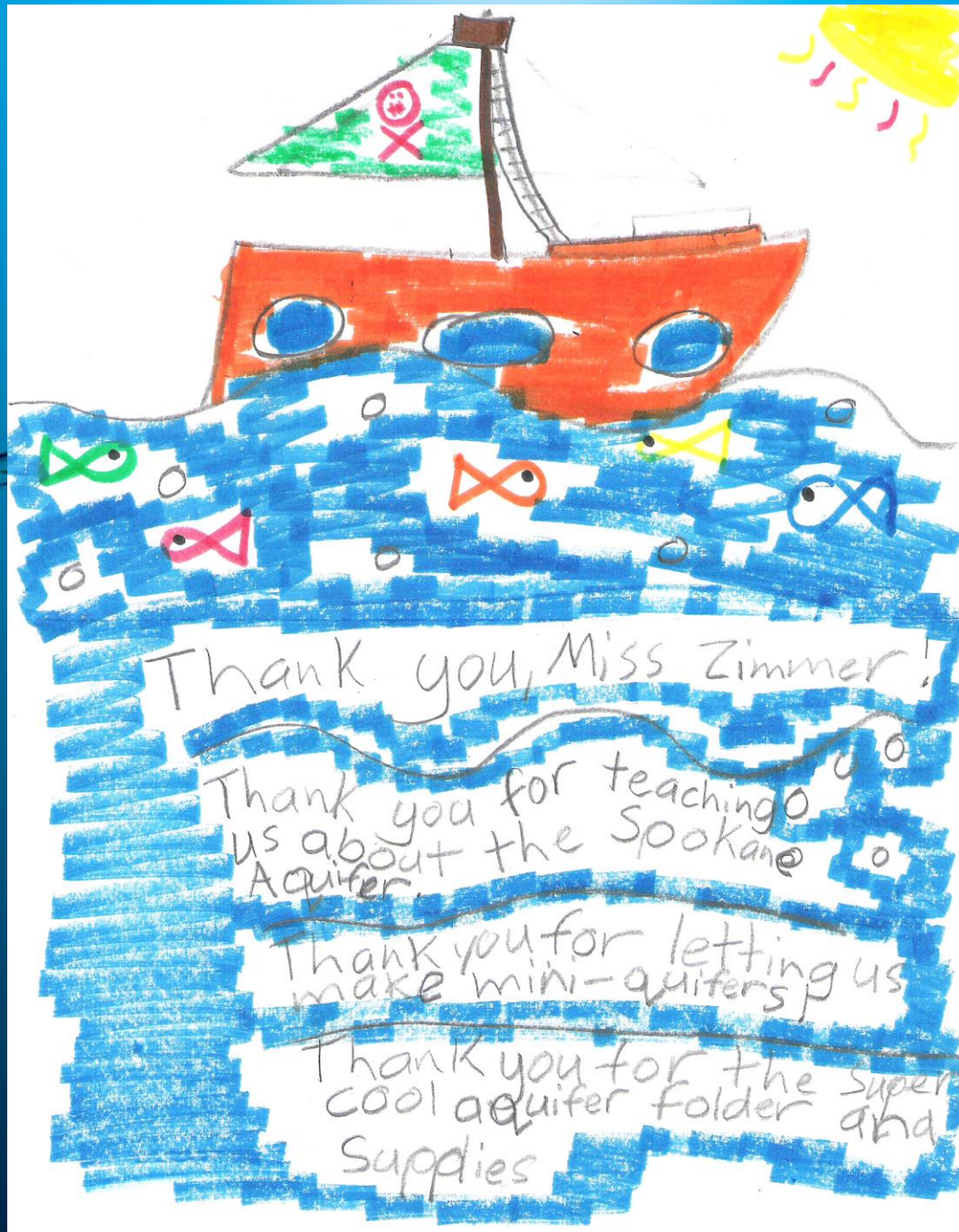

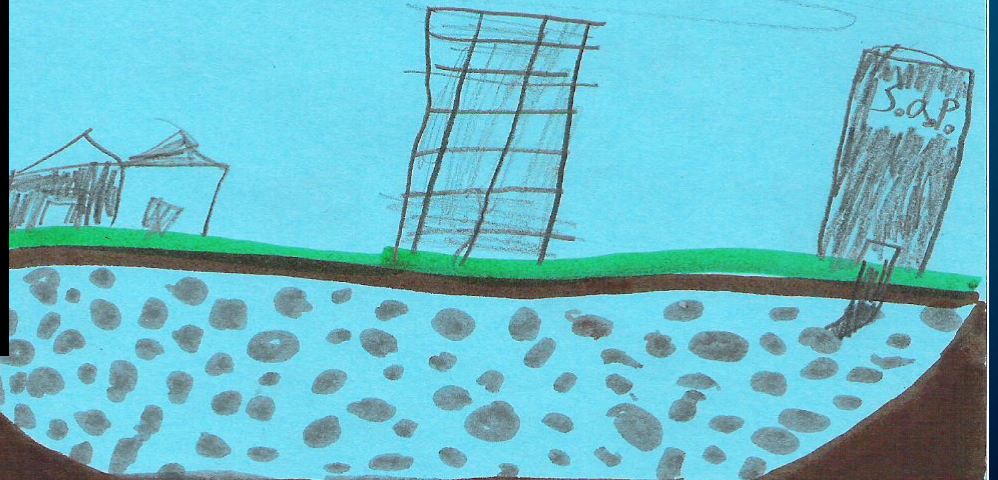
