2014 Education and Awareness Events – In March 2014, school science nights were held at Mullan Road, Opportunity and Audubon Elementary Schools. PM Hanson was not able to attend these events in person so boxes of materials were prepared and delivered to each school in advance of the events. Materials for each school included: 35 Aquifer Atlases, 20 Household Hazardous Chemicals brochures, 35 pens and 60 of each comic book, 60 aquifer folders and placemats
