
AQUA DUCK'S TOP FIVE

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE TIPS

- 1: Household Hazards include Corrosive Cleaners, Automotive fluids, Batteries, Fluorescent Light Bulbs, Pesticides, Herbicides, and anything labeled danger, caution, warning, toxic or poisonous.
- 2: Use substitute products that are less toxic to reduce your exposure to hazardous materials. To find more information about alternatives to hazardous products go with a parent to www.ecy.wa.gov/toxicfreetips.
- **3:** Use up products before purchasing new to avoid having several containers of hazardous waste in your home.
- **4:** Buy the smallest quantity of product that will complete your job and reduce the amount of Household Hazardous Waste you generate.
- **5:** Take unwanted Household Hazardous Waste to the Regional Solid Waste System sites.

TO SWALLOW UP.




DENSITY- THE DEGREE OF COMPACTNESS OF A SUBSTANCE.
