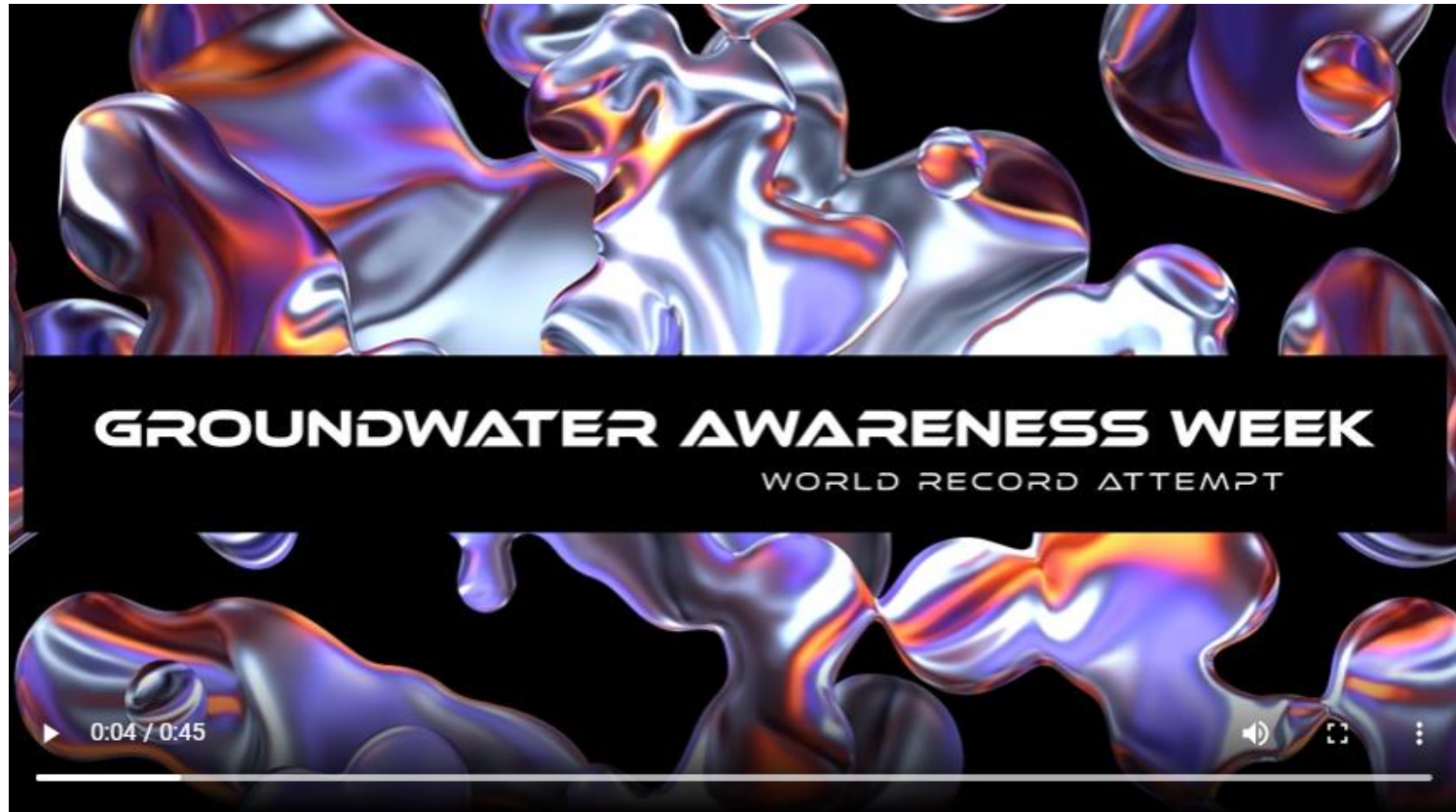

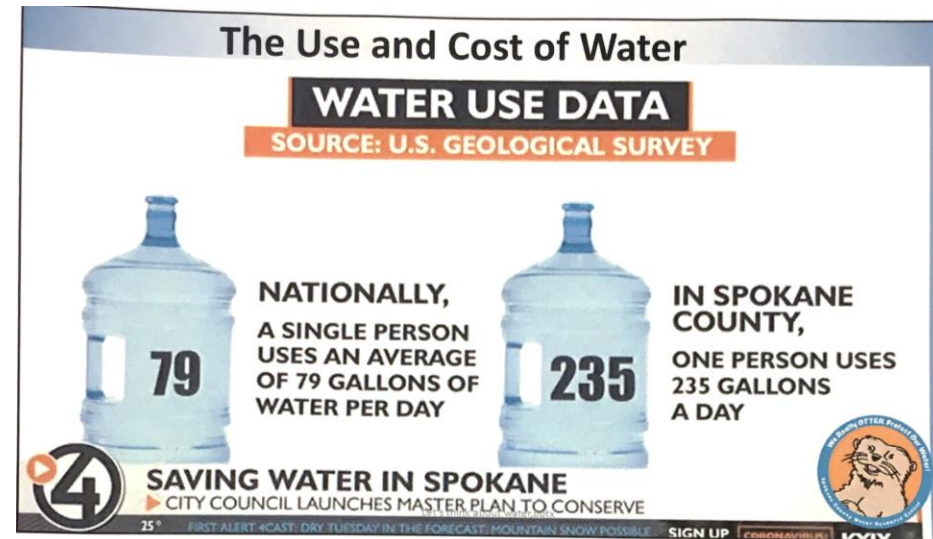

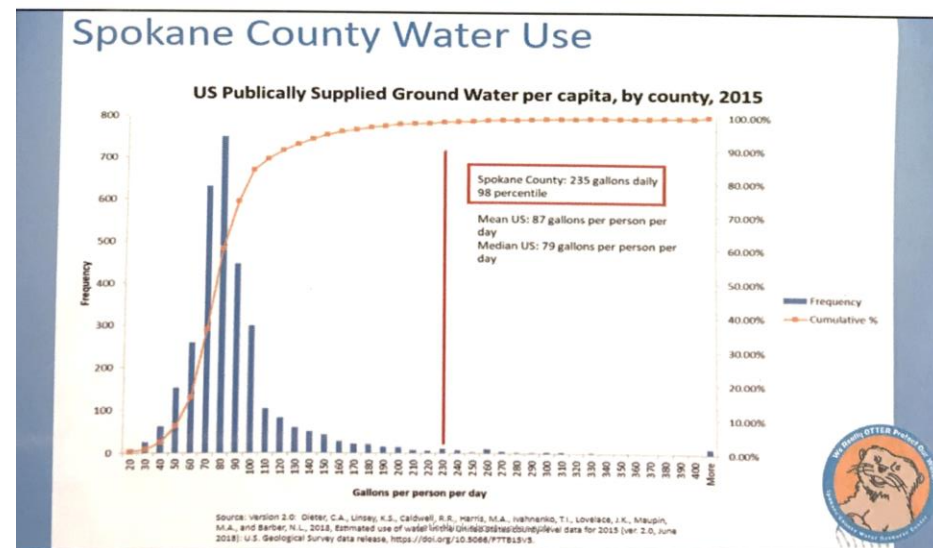
2022 Aquifer Atlas Redesign
